Evolution of Greater Mercer TMA's Work Program



1980's

Tremendous growth and increased congestion

- 75% increase in daily work trips projected by NJDOT
- Private business sector becomes increasingly concerned
- Leads to formation of GMTMA in 1984 as a private, non-profit membership organization
- Focus on reducing congestion during the work trip



2000's

Getting cars off the road AND getting people onto the mode they need

- Establish senior transportation program, RideProvide, in 2006
- United We Ride, CHSTP, travel training
- Focus on Mobility, not Mode



1992, NJ Traffic Congestion and Air Pollution Control Act

- Established transportation demand management program
- Employee trip reduction plans required
- In 1996 the mandatory trip reductions were repealed
- Began to broaden our reach and mission

Door to Door


